

ABOUT SIOC-CDT MATRIC BURSARY SCHEME

The SIOC Community Development Trust ("SIOC-cdt) is a development organisation registered at the Master of High Court to be the custodian of development initiatives on behalf of its beneficiary communities. These communities include Thabazimbi Local Municipality (Limpopo province), Tsantsabane Local Municipality (ZF Mgcawu District, Northern Cape) and the John Taolo Gaetsewe District (Northern Cape province).

Who is eligible to apply? Any Citizen who is a resident of the beneficiary communities listed above • <35 years old • average pass mark of 65% • in financial need to fund under/postgraduate study • people living with disabilities will get first preference

What to submit

- ⇒ A completed SIOC-cdt Bursary Application form
- ⇒ A certified copy of latest matric results including mid-year Grade 12 results, or latest university/college academic results where application for funding is for 2nd year onwards
- Proof of acceptance at a recognised, public Higher Education Institution (University or TVET/FET College)
- One-page cover letter to motivate your case for financial need
- A certified copy of your South African ID
