REGISTER TO VOTE

Thabazimbi Community Representative Trustee

Electronic Voter Registration

12 Sept - 23 Sept 2025

Manual Voter Registration

20 Sept - 21 Sept 2025

Only registered community members will be eligible to vote.

How do I get involved?

STEP 1: NOMINATIONS

- Self nomination or by others
- Complete a nomination form
- Obtain support, in writing or via SMS from the community members residing within the same municipal jurisdiction
- On SIOC-CDT and IEFSA websites www.sioc-cdt.co.za & www.iefsa.co.za
- Publishing of shortlisted nominees
- Candidate vetting process
- Final candidates list publishing

STEP 2: REGISTRATION

- Register in person or online
- To register, you must:
 - ×

 be at least 18 years old



- be in possession of proof of residence
- reside within the same municipal jurisdiction (Thabazimbi)
- be in possession of a SA Identity Document/Smart Card

STEP 3: VOTING PROCESS

- To participate, you should be a resident of Thabazimbi Local Municipality and have registered to vote
- Your name must appear on the EIFSA/SIOC-CDT votes roll.
- Voting at designated voting stations within the Thabazimbi Local Municipality area
- Online Voting



General background information

SIOC Community Development Trust (SIOC-CDT) hereby invites communities in Thabazimbi to take part in the SIOC-CDT election process to **elect a candidate** to serve as a community representative and member of the Board of Trustees.



SIOC-CDT was established by its Donor, Sishen Iron Ore Company (Pty) Ltd, for the benefit of the communities in the Northern Cape Province(Gamagara, Ga-Segonyana, Joe Morolong and Tsantsabane) and Thabazimbi (Limpopo Province) who are impacted by its mining activities. This was to ensure that, in the long run, beneficiary communities and can thrive beyond the life of the mining activities contributing to more reduced poverty and resilient, self-sustaining and empowered communities.



A Community Representative Trustee shall be elected by community members and appointed to the SIOC-CDT Board of Trustees to represent the respective beneficiary community.

Who can be a **SIOC-CDT Trustee?**

Section 20(2) of the Trust Property Control Act, 1988 (Act 57 of 1988) stipulates that a trustee should be a person who has never been:

- x convicted of any offence of dishonesty or sentenced to prison without a fine option
- x sequestrated or liquidated or placed under judicial management
- x removed from office in respect to any appointment as a trustee
- x declared with a mental health disability or incapacitated

In addition, the SIOC-CDT trust deed specifies the following criteria. A person does not qualify to be appointed as a trustee if they are:

- × over 70 years of age
- × working for government or parliament in any capacity

The **nominated person** must:

- ✓ have a minimun of Grade 12 qualification
- ✓ reside within the municipal jurisdiction for which you are nominated
- ✓ at least be able to read and/or write
