Only registered community members will be eligible to vote.

How do I get **involved?**

STEP 1: NOMINATIONS

- Self nomination or by others
- Complete a nomination form on SIOC-CDT and IEFSA websites www.sioc-cdt.co.za & www.iefsa.co.za
- Obtain support, in writing or via SMS from the community members residing within the same municipal jurisdiction (Thabazimbi)
- Publishing of shortlisted nominees
- Candidate vetting process
- Final candidates list publishing

STEP 2: REGISTRATION

- Register in person or online
- To register, you must:
 - ✓ be at least 18 years old



- ✓ be in possession of a proof of residence to indicate that you are a resident of Thabazimbi
- ✓ be in possession of a SA Identity Document/Smart Card

STEP 3: VOTING PROCESS

- To participate, you should be a resident of Thabazimbi Local Municipality and have registered to vote
- Your name must appear on the EIFSA/SIOC-CDT votes roll.
- Voting at designated voting stations within the Thabazimbi Local Municipality area
- Online Voting.



General background *information*

SIOC Community Development Trust (SIOC-CDT) hereby invites communities in **Thabazimbi** to take part in the SIOC-CDT election process to **elect a candidate** to serve as a community representative and member of the **Board of Trustees**.



SIOC-CDT was established in 2006 by **Sishen Iron Ore Company (Pty) Ltd** to implement socioeconomic development projects in communities adjacent to its mining operations in the **Northern Cape (JTG District and Tsantabane Local Municipality) and Limpopo province** (Thabazimbi Local Municipality). The vision of SIOC-CDT is to ensure that beneficiary communities have sustainable income and are empowered to thrive beyond the lifespan of the mine.



A Community Representative Trustee shall be elected by community members and appointed to the SIOC-CDT Board of Trustees to represent the Thabazimbi beneficiary community.

Who can be a **SIOC-CDT Trustee?**

- Any person who has not been disqualified under TPCA s6(1A), NPO Act s25A, or Companies Act s69
- Section 20(2) of the Trust Property Control Act, 1988 (Act 57 of 1988) stipulates that a trustee should be a **person who has never been:**
 - ✗ convicted of any offence of dishonesty or sentenced to prison without an option of a fine
 - ✗ sequestrated or liquidated or placed under judicial management
 - ✗ removed from office in respect to any appointment as a trustee
 - ✗ declared with a mental health disability or incapacitated
- In addition, the SIOC-CDT trust deed specifies the following criteria. A person **does not qualify** to be appointed as a trustee if they are:
 - ✗ over 70 years of age
 - ✗ working for government or parliament in any capacity

The **nominated person** must:

 - ✓ have a minimum of Grade 12 qualification
 - ✓ reside within the municipal jurisdiction for which you are nominated

NB: Only female candidates are permitted to stand for nomination in these elections
